About the Information Briefing

This 1.5 hour audio-visual presentation will inform Headteachers, Senior Leaders, Local authority officers and other colleagues about the trainings provided by Trauma Informed Schools UK, namely senior leads training (2 days), whole school staff training (half or whole day) and 10 day work-based learning Diploma for school staff to become specialist mental health and trauma informed practitioners. The session will provide understanding of the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences on pupils' learning and progress. In fact statistics show that 97 percent of children with no adverse childhood experiences have no learning difficulties or behaviour problems (Burke et al 2011). The session will also include research showing how training staff to address the unmet emotional needs

of children (cost reducing not cost increasing) can increase attainment and improve behaviour and attendance. There will also be focus on whole school cultural shift to develop mentally healthy school practice for all (staff and students).

The session will explore some of the key interventions covered on the course, illustrated by moving and emotionally powerful case studies. Finally there will be a brief demonstration of Motional, an online assessment tool, which supports you to produce programmes of action and track progress through your trauma and mental health Informed work with children and young people. There will be opportunity for questions and answers.
